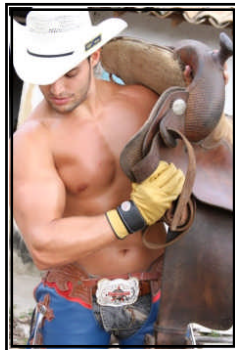

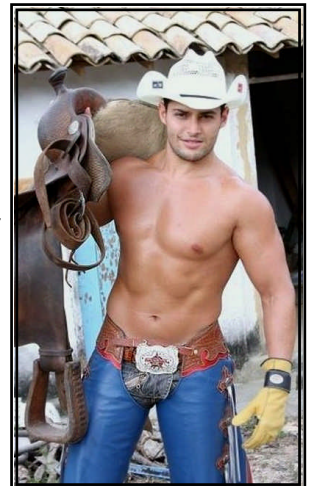

**Ask Dr. Jones**

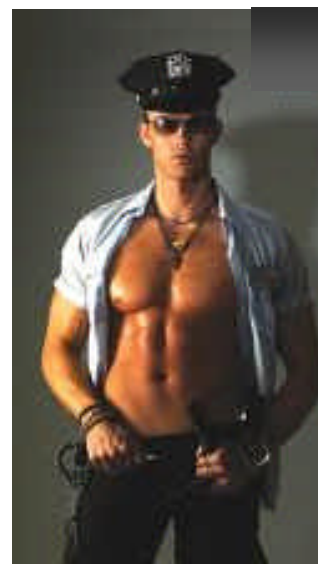
Dear Dr. Jones:
