Iona Traylor's Helpful Tips and Tidbits

Let's talk about DECKS! Why are decks such a big deal? Well, they are a Trailer owners most coveted and prize possession, forget that metallic palace you been working so hard for all these years. It's your deck that counts! The bigger you can make your deck the better. The higher you can get your deck of the ground, the more people can see your deck. Personally, I always like to light up my deck so everybody can admire it. At the holidays, I make sure my deck is covered in shiny ornaments; it will draw a crowd and it's a sure-fire way to get folks to stop and stare at your deck. If you deck is good and sturdy, it will hold a lot of people.

You have to be careful though, if you try to put too much on your deck, it could cause it to sink down and nobody wants to look at a crooked deck. It also can be hard to stand upright and you could slip off a crooked deck. It is always a good idea to wash your deck regularly. I like to use a mixture of bleach and Palmolive, it will kill germs and also get rid of anything sticky on your deck. Also, you may want to keep your bushes trimmed around your deck. It will make your deck look much bigger than it really is.
